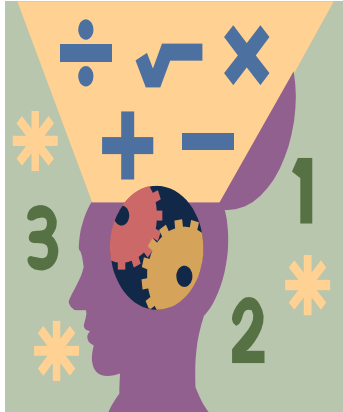


2018 MLHS Math Bowl

Dear Principals,



Your students are invited to participate in this year's Manitowoc Lutheran High School's Elementary Math Bowl. This year's math bowl will be held in conjunction with our Academic Fair on Saturday, April 14th. The contest will be a timed contest, which will consist of 4 individual written rounds (4 questions each) and a team round of 6 questions. The students will have 15 minutes to complete each round. Points are scored for responding to the problem in simplest form. A calculator will be allowed for the team event only. This follows a similar format to our high school math league.

A team will consist of five members, **with at most 3** eighth graders. Each school may enter as many of these 5 member teams as they would like. Each school entering a team is asked to have a teacher or advisor present on the day of the meet. They will monitor or help score the contests. Also each participating school is asked to submit ten challenging yet appropriate problems for the contest. Please send these to the email listed below as soon as possible. They may be used to write the contest. Please do not share these questions with your students in advance.

Awards will be given to the individuals with the highest 5 scores on the first 4 contests in grades five, six, seven and eight. We will award the top three teams in the math bowl with ribbons. A team plaque is also awarded to the highest team score.
